


Exodus 3:13



In The Bible, Most Names Had Meanings.

Noah, the man who preached 120 years and built the ark, means “rest, peaceful, comfort.”

Abram means “exalted father.” **Abraham** means “Father of many nations.”

God changed Sarai’s name to **Sarah** meaning “Princess.”

Abraham and Sarah had a son, and named him **Isaac**, meaning “Laughter.”

Jonah, the prophet who was sent to preach to the people of Nineveh, means “dove and peace.”

Esther means “star.” This was the name she was given *after* she entered the royal harem. It is a Syro-Arabian name. Her Jewish name was Hadas’sah, which means, “the myrtle.”



Superman's Jewish Roots

Superman was first conceived in 1933 by writer Jerry Siegel and artist Joe Shuster, both teenagers in Cleveland and the children of Jewish immigrants. In the Depression-era Midwest, the pair escaped their high school existences by dreaming up science fiction and fantasy stories. The character went through a few iterations as Siegel workshopped it, transforming from a bald scientist portrayed as a villain into the flying caped hero that is so well-known today. In 1938, Siegel and Shuster famously sold the rights to Superman to the company now known as DC Comics for only \$130.

Along with the web content, Dr. Craig Detweiller, Ph.D. of Theology and Culture, wrote a nine page essay titled "Jesus—The Original Superhero" to specifically link the Last Son of Krypton with the Son of God. Detweiller cited the oft repeated evidence about the suffix "el" appending Superman's Kryptonian birth name "Kal-el." In Hebrew, the "el" suffix is used to denote Elohim, or Yahweh, Jehovah, or God, like in the names Michael, Ariel, and Raphael. In his essay, Detweiller also referenced the Jochebedian orphanization Superman suffered as his parents, forewarned of the planet Krypton's imminent demise, shot their baby into outer space like a futuristic Moses.
