All you had to do was mean you were about to say something of importance or, when meant sarcastically, to indicate that another person's statement was old news.

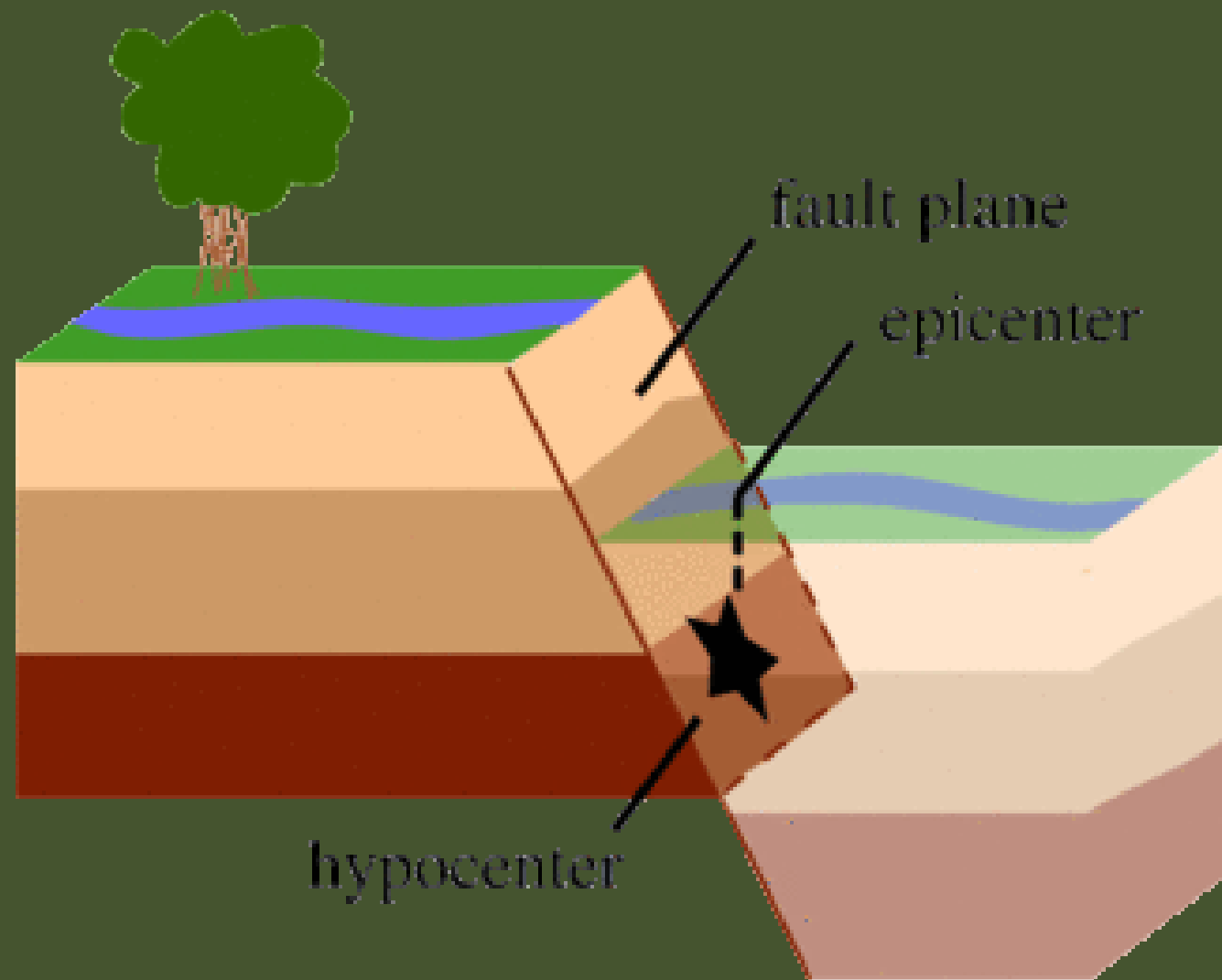

Foreshocks, Mainshock and Aftershocks

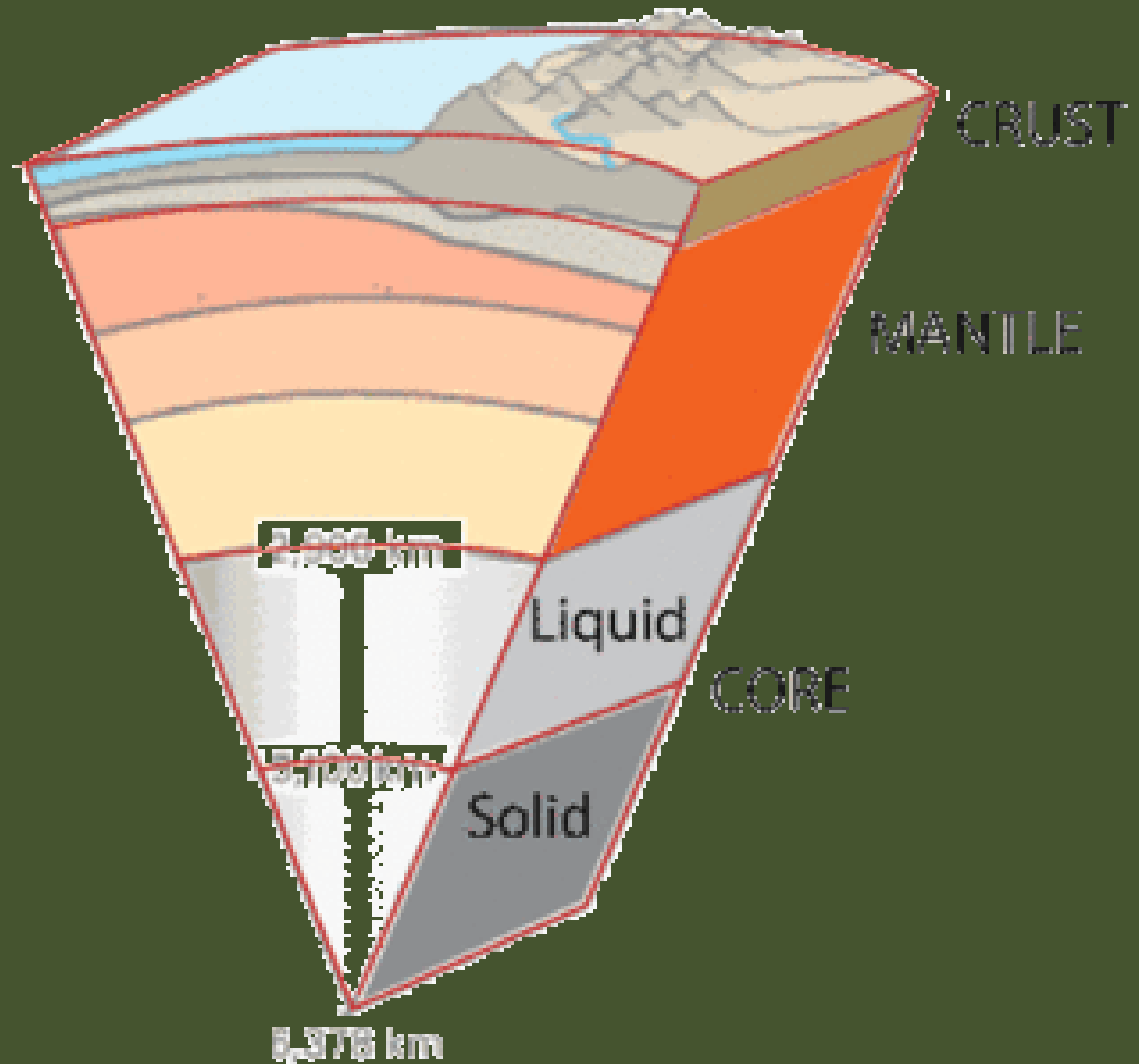
Sometimes an earthquake has **foreshocks**. These are smaller earthquakes that happen in the same place as the larger earthquake that follows. Scientists can't tell that an earthquake is a foreshock until the larger earthquake happens.

The largest, main earthquake is called the **mainshock**.

Mainshocks always have **aftershocks** that follow. These are smaller earthquakes that occur afterwards in the same place as the mainshock. Depending on the size of the mainshock, aftershocks can continue for weeks, months, and even years after the mainshock!

The earth has four major layers: the inner core, outer core, mantle and crust. The crust and the top of the mantle make up a thin skin on the surface of our planet.

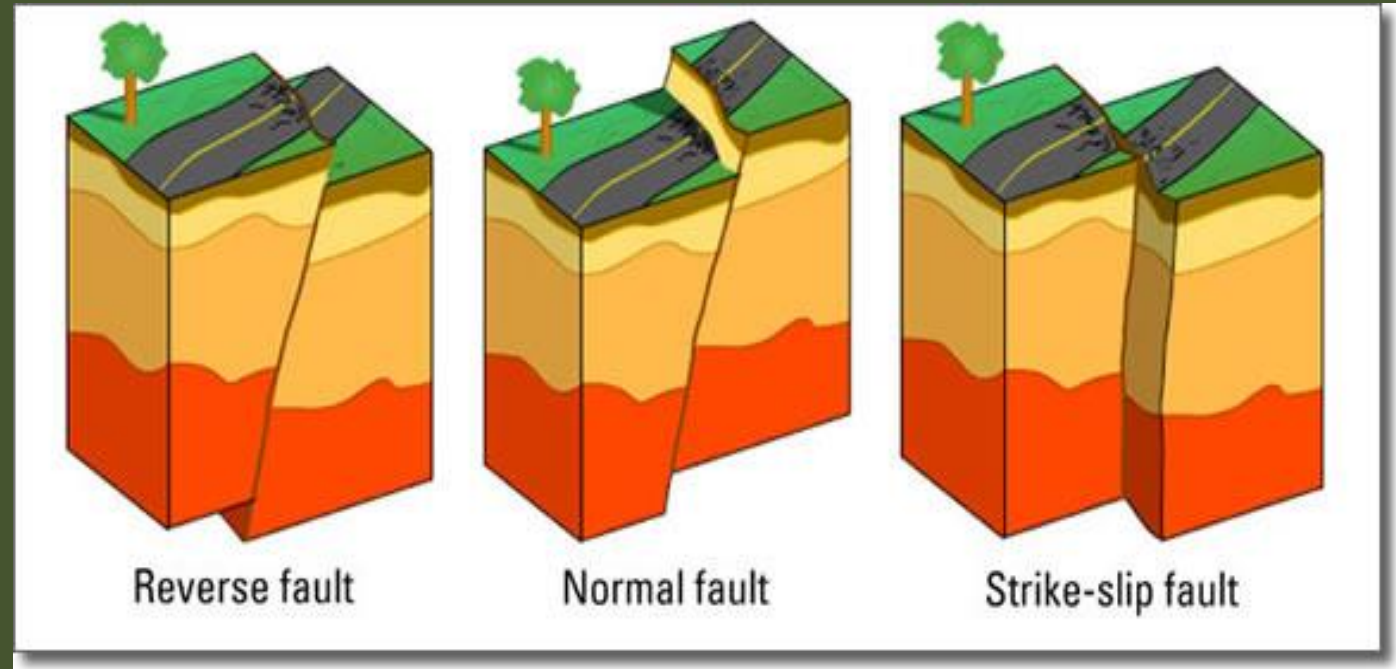

We call these puzzle pieces tectonic plates, and the edges of the plates are called the plate boundaries. 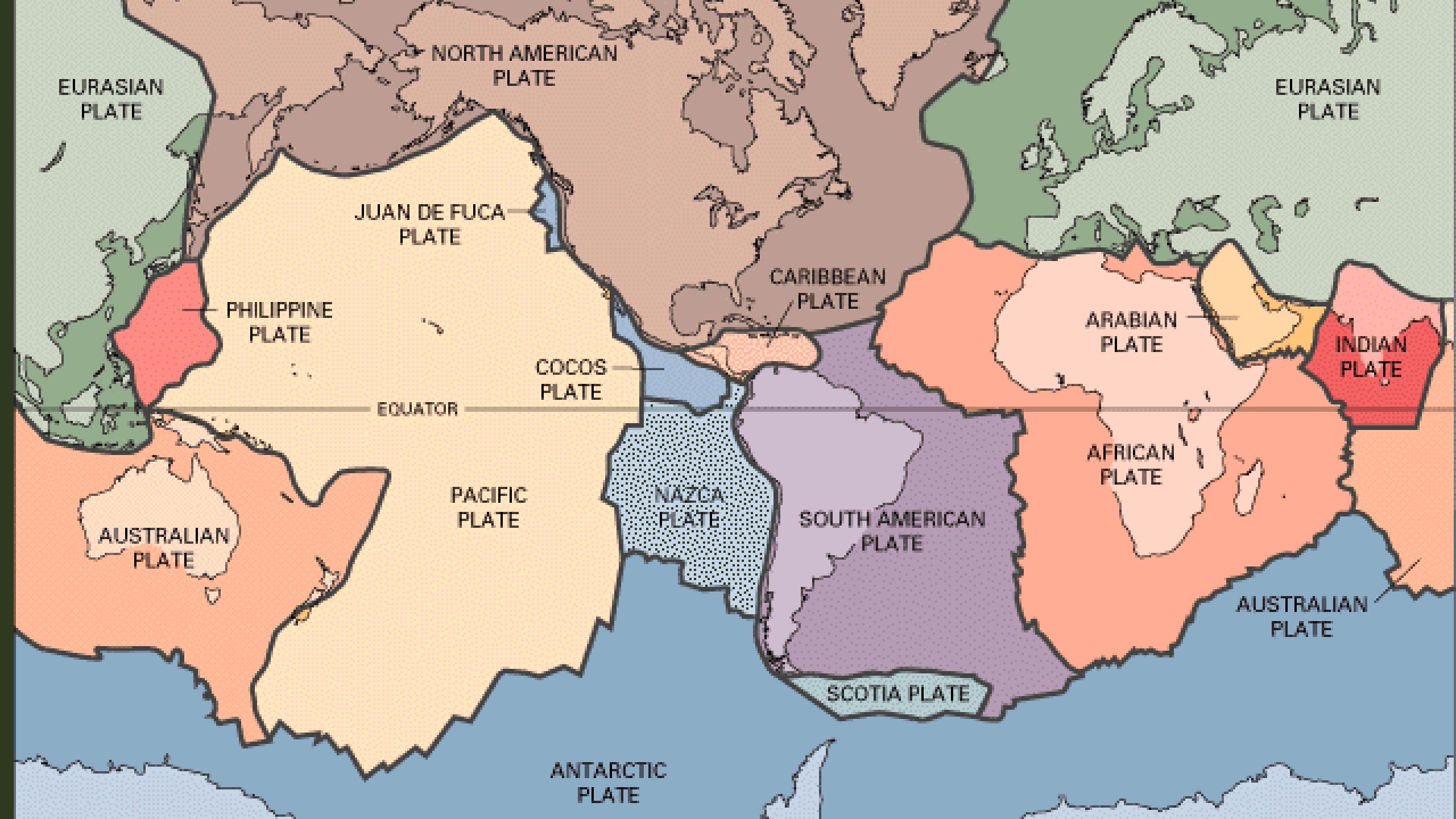


Tectonic Plates and Plate Boundaries

4 And for fear of him the keepers did shake, and became as dead men.

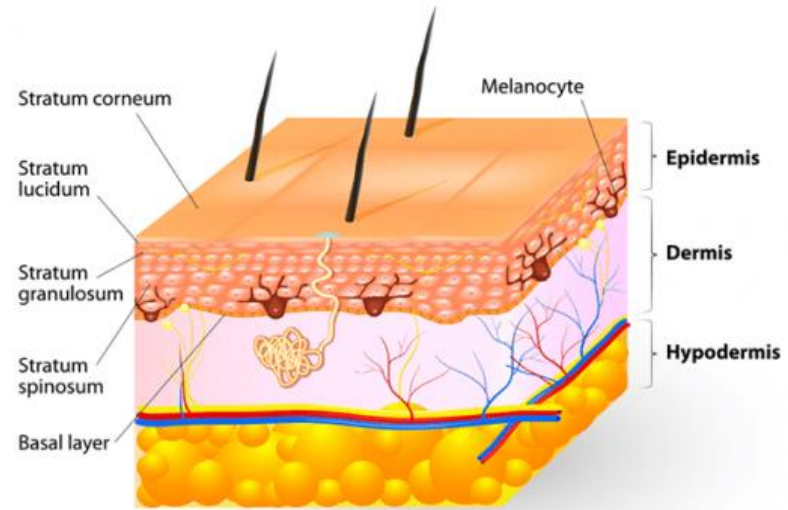
5 And the angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified.

THE LAYERS OF HUMAN SKIN



The layers of human skin

The core of the human body is considered the torso.

In common parlance, the core of the body is broadly considered to be the torso.

Functional movements are highly dependent on this part of the body, and lack of core muscular development can result in a predisposition to injury.

The major muscles of the core reside in the area of the belly and the mid and lower back (not the shoulders), and peripherally include[clarification needed] the hips, the shoulders and the neck.
