


Matthew 1:18,19



18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit.

19 Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly.



- ♦ Joseph by trade was a carpenter.
- That placed him near the bottom of the socioeconomic ladder of his day.
- ♦ A carpenter from a long line of kings.



In the genealogy provided by Matthew Joseph was a carpenter with a rich heritage.



Joseph was a descendent of Abraham which made him a member of the chosen race.




He was also a descendant of Israel which made him a member of the chosen nation.



He was directly descendent from Judah which placed him solidly in the tribe of the kings.







If fate had played his hand differently, he could have been king.



But the long line of failures in his holy line left him a carpenter in Caesar's kingdom.



To make matters worse, Joseph was named after Joseph.







Joseph

Joseph was the son of Jacob who was taken into captivity and he lived all his life under the rule of another kingdom.



Joseph's name is appropriate here.



He had lived all his life in captivity under Roman rule.



In the Gospel of Matthew Joseph is in a long list of names in a genealogy that looks like its going nowhere.




Joseph's claim to fame is the Son of God – not his name.




The introduction of Jesus into the genealogy makes all the difference in the world for Joseph.








The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham:



Matthew 1:1


Which is literally translated:

"The Book of the <u>Genesis</u> of Jesus Christ – son of David – son of Abraham."



Matthew 1:1

Matthew declares that Jesus is the new Adam - the beginning of a new creation...the Genesis of Jesus!




In the Next 15 verses of Matthew we find a fascinating genealogy that starts with Abraham and it ends with Jesus.




Looking at the genealogy, Jesus had every reason to fail as far as his family system was concerned.




- Abraham was a polygamist.
- Isaac lied to save his life.
- Jacob tried to steal his brother's birthright.



- Judah sold his bother into slavery and committed adultery.
- Tamar performed the work of a prostitute to gain children by Judah.
- Rahab was a prostitute too.




- Ruth was a Moabites. She tried to entice an intoxicated Boaz on the threshing floor to gain his favor.
- David murdered a man to steal his wife.




- Solomon led God's people into Idolatry.
- Rehaboam oppressed his people and destroyed the unity of the empire.
- Uzziah committed blasphemy and profaned the temple.



By any definition Jesus was connected to a dysfunctional family.



Jesus is a new genesis for failed families.



The meaning of the genealogy is summarized in Matthew 1:17.



So all the generations from Abraham to David were fourteen generations, and from David to the deportation to Babylon fourteen generations, and from the deportation to Babylon to the Christ fourteen generations.




Matthew 1:17

The Genealogy is comprised of three groupings of 14, which together adds up to 42.




The Number

In Numbers 33, Israel camped 42 times before they entered the Promised Land.



The Number

42 months is three and half years – a time, times, and dividing of times.




The Number

In the book of Revelation the church goes into the wilderness for 42 months.




The number 42 represents a time of wilderness wandering.



From Abraham to Jesus the people of God wandered without God's true shepherd.









Joseph


In the genealogy Jesus is born as number 42.




Jesus represents the transition from captivity to freedom.



Jesus is the only way out of the wilderness.




Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child of the Holy Spirit;

The Greek says literally, "Now the Genesis of Jesus took place in this way."



Genesis of Jesus

"In the Beginning" the gospel of Matthew starts with a scandal.

after her








The text says, "before they came together she was found to be with child...of the Holy Spirit."











If you were unfaithful at that time, you were considered an adulteress or an adulterer.











If Joseph had exposed Mary publically, Joseph would have no doubt avoided the stigma of violating the waiting time of the engagement.



Unless Joseph exposed Mary publically, he would no doubt become himself a possible candidate for the man that had made Mary pregnant before the appointed time of marriage.



So Joseph's decision to divorce her quietly left Joseph with the stigma of suspicion.



Matthew 1:20 But as he considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit;



Joseph was not a theologian, but he knew who the Holy Spirit was in the law of Moses.



The spirit of God is present in the very lines of scripture at the creation of the world.




Genesis 1:1, 2

² The earth was without form and void, and darkness was upon the face of the deep; and the Spirit of God was moving over the face of the waters.






How do you fix a mess you didn't make?

 How do you extract yourself from a scandal you don't deserve?

 How do your survive the shame and the blame for the crime you did not commit? The angel in the dream told Joseph that the Holy Spirit was the one who made Mary pregnant.





Imagine Joseph trying to explain the whole thing at the door of the synagogue.



With a stutter in his voice he says:

"I'm planning to marry Mary.

Yes she's pregnant.

No the Baby is not mine.

Yes we're engaged.

But the baby isn't anyone else's either.


It's true – really!

The baby has a mother – but no Daddy.

I'm just a fill in.

Mary is the first woman in history to have a baby without a man to help her have the baby.





At that point the scandal moves into the realm of blasphemy and there is little doubt left in anyone's mind at the door of the synagogue that Joseph is crazy.



As the Angel comes to Joseph in a dream, Joseph is the one at the center of the scandal right there with Mary.





The message of the angel is pretty clear. Joseph - marry Mary - and adopt that little boy she's carrying as your little boy.




Matthew 1:21 she will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."









In any scenario, you don't have a right to name a child that is not yours.



And so the command of the angel is the offer to a man with an uncertain future – the choice - to adopt the little Lord Jesus.



The Son of God must become the son of Joseph, the carpenter, to become the son of David and the son of Adam.



His people must choose him by Joseph's choice for Him to save his people from their sins.



Joseph was named after the son of Jacob who would become Israel.



The ancient Joseph went to Egypt and lived in captivity.

He saved his brothers, his Father, and his whole family from famine and certain death.

He brought them all to Egypt and he protected them from a certain death in a foreign land.

The new Joseph stands on a new plain in salvation history.

The new Israel is not a nation this time.

The new Israel in the gospel of Matthew is a child.

Matthew 2:14,15

14 And he rose and took
the child and his mother
by night, and departed to
Egypt,

and remained there until the death of Herod. This was to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet, "Out of Egypt have I called my son."



And like Joseph in the Old Testament, the new Joseph will lead the new Israel into Egypt to save his life from king Herod.



And just like Israel in the Old Testament, God will lead his son out of Egypt in the New Testament.




His people - from Abraham to Joseph – His people.


42 generations until Jesus.

42 is the number for the wilderness.

There were 42 stages in Numbers 33 from Egypt to the promised land.







Joseph is the son of captivity who goes to Egypt and leads Israel into Egypt.

Joshua is the leader after Moses who will take his people to the Promised Land and conquer the enemies of God.



The only way to be saved is to have a new deliver who is strong enough to take God's people to the promised land.



In his dream that night, Joseph understood the angel's command well.

The child in Mary's womb is no doubt the Son of God.

The force behind the scandal in the night is the Holy Spirit.

And the choice that gives him a home is Joseph's to make.

You shall call his name Jesus – Joshua!

And he will save his people from their sins.



Joseph could have walked away from the nightmare of the dream and the command of the angel.


He could have said, "I'm done with nightmares like this one."

I don't need this kind of stress in my life.


But he didn't do it.

He accepted Jesus as his son with the entire stigma and all the shame that comes with the scandal of salvation that is the Genesis of Jesus.

Like Joseph, you cannot be saved unless you accept the scandal of the Christ child this Christmas.



To be a Christian means to align with Christ and to recognize that Jesus is the deliverer and not you.



The angel said, "He will save his people from their sins."

Who qualifies here as his people?

John 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world knew him not.



John 1:11 He came to his own home, and his own people received him not.




John 1:12 But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God;




John 1:13 who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

The Angel said:

Matthew 1:24-25 24 When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him; he took his wife, 25 but knew her not until she had borne a son; and he called his name Joshua.
