Stewardship


• **Stewardship** is an ethic that embodies the responsible planning and management of resources.

- He created us.



- Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed, And in Your books they all were written, The days fashioned for me, When as yet there were none of them.


Why are we stewards?

 God is the sustainer of our lives




