³ Some Pharisees came to him to test him. They asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his <u>wife for any and</u> <u>every reason?</u>"



24 If a man marries a woman who becomes displeasing to him because he finds something *indecent about her*, and he writes her a certificate of divorce, gives it to her and sends her from his house, Deuteronomy 24:1

E. R. Aqiba says, "Even if he found some one else


prettier than she,
